Encounter 23 prehistoric creatures as you stroll along the Zoo's Desert Lives Trail. This self-guided tour includes animatronic dinosaurs, which move and make various sounds including the infamous roar of the tyrannosaurus rex. A fossil dig and a photo op with a pachyrhino are also available. Educational signage and guides highlight size and interesting facts.

You will purchase you own entry into the Zoo. This allows for those who have Zoo memberships or discounts. The current adult entry is \$24.95 which grants you access to all the animals.
