Directions: From Phoenix, take I-17 N to Carefree Highway (SR 74). Exit Carefree Hwy. and travel W 15 miles to Castle Hot Spring Road. Travel N to Park entrance. After checking in, go ½ mile further and turn right on SOUTH PARK RD. Continue for .2 miles and then turn right onto Chalky Springs Dr. This is the group site.
