**GENERAL INFORMATION**

*A magnificent collection of art comprised of oils, watercolors, pastel and charcoal drawings, and bronze sculptures by renowned Cowboy Artists John Clymer, Joe Beeler, Jim Reynolds, Howard Terpning, David Halbach, Bill Owen and many others. The collection also includes several works by American Indian Contemporary Artists Clifford Beck, David Johns, Cecil Calnimpewa, Dennis Tewa, Larry Yazzie, Oreland Joe, Al Qoyawayma, Wilmer Kay and many others portraying oils, watercolors, pastels, basketry, pottery, alabaster and marble sculptures, as well as kachinas. There are well over 3500 pieces displayed throughout the gallery.*

**FROM MESA, TEMPE OR CHANDLER:**

*Drive South on Alma School Road off the 60 to Ocotillo Road (approx six miles from Chandler Blvd). Left (east) on Ocotillo Road to Basha Road (approx half mile). Right (south) on Basha Road. Take the second right off of Basha Road. Both the first and second rights are entrances/driveways into the complex. The second right puts you at the far south end of the largest building which is where visitor parking is as well as the reception entrance and entrance to the gallery.*

**FROM PHOENIX**

*Drive South on Interstate 10 as if going to Tucson. Exit I-10 at Queen Creek Road, Exit #164). Left (east on Queen Creek to Alma School Road (approx 5 miles). Right (south) on Alma School Road to Ocotillo Road. Left (east) on Ocotillo Road to Basha Road. Right (south) on Basha Road. Both the first and second rights are entrances/driveways into the complex. The second right puts you at the far south end of the largest building which is where visitor parking is as well as the reception entrance and entrance to the gallery.*

**FROM SCOTTSDALE**

*Head South on the 101. (Do not get on Hwy. 60) Exit at Price Road Exit # 61A and continue south on Price Road (this exit is just past the Chandler Boulevard exit). Continue South on Price Road to Queen Creek Road. Left (east) on Queen Creek Road to Alma School (approx 2 miles). Right (south) on Alma School Road to Ocotillo Road. Left (east) on Ocotillo Road to Basha Road. Right (south) on Basha Road. Both the first and second rights are entrances/driveways into the complex. The second right puts you at the far south end of the largest building which is where visitor parking is as well as the reception entrance and entrance to the gallery.*

**FROM TUCSON**

*Drive North on I-10 as if going to Phoenix. Exit I-10 at Queen Creek Road. Right (east) on Queen Creek Road to Alma School (approx 5 miles). Right (south) on Alma School Road to Ocotillo Road. Left (east) on Ocotillo Road to Basha Road. Right (south) on Basha Road. Both the first and second rights are entrances/driveways into the complex. The second right puts you at the far south end of the largest building which is where visitor parking is as well as the reception entrance and entrance to the gallery.*

**NOTE TO ALL:** *While driving south on Alma School Road, you will see road signs before you reach Ocotillo Road that say “Basha Road”. Please continue south to Ocotillo Road and take Ocotillo Road to Basha Road. This route allows you to divert going through a residential neighborhood. Please carpool as parking is limited. Thank you.*
